One of the benefits cited most frequently by ASTHVI members is our rapid response and peer support, including through the COVID-19 pandemic. In the last few years, ASTHVI members have collectively tackled the challenges brought on by the coronavirus, including best practices for remote home visiting; strategies, frameworks and questions for an eventual return to in-person visits; preparing for remote monitoring and site visits; and more. Following these calls, ASTHVI shared impactful feedback from state and Tribal administrators with HRSA and ACF, partners in the field, and policymakers to provide insight on the challenges home visitors are facing on the ground. ASTHVI also collected stories and examples from around the country highlighting the incredible services and support home visitors continue to provide to disadvantaged families during these unprecedented circumstances, and provided those examples to policymakers to help inform their legislative response to the pandemic.

ASTHVI's members-only listserv and online discussion board provide a space for administrators to ask questions and receive answers in real time, without being inundated by extraneous information. Our committees and working groups meet regularly, offering members additional opportunities to give assistance to, and receive help from, peers and contribute to policy development for MIECHV.
