



HOME VISITING IN New Hampshire

Home Visiting Models

New Hampshire has a wide range of home visiting models across the state including evidence based home visiting models as well as home grown home visiting programs.

The evidence based home visiting model funded by MIECHV in NH is:

- **Healthy Families America**



Of those that reported belonging to a priority population:

- 61% were low income
- 59% have a child with developmental delays or disabilities
- 48% of families had a history of SUD or were in need of treatment
- 41% had a history of child maltreatment or had interactions with child welfare services



Evidence based home visiting services, utilizing the Healthy Families America model are available in all NH counties.

All programs in NH utilize an evidence based curriculum, either Growing Great Kids or Parents as Teachers.

In FY 2021, the MIECHV program provided services to **380** NH Families.

The MIECHV grant provides funding to support **248** families at a time in NH.

The majority of NH families receiving HFA were screened utilizing validated tools for depression, parent child interaction, development, and intimate partner violence.

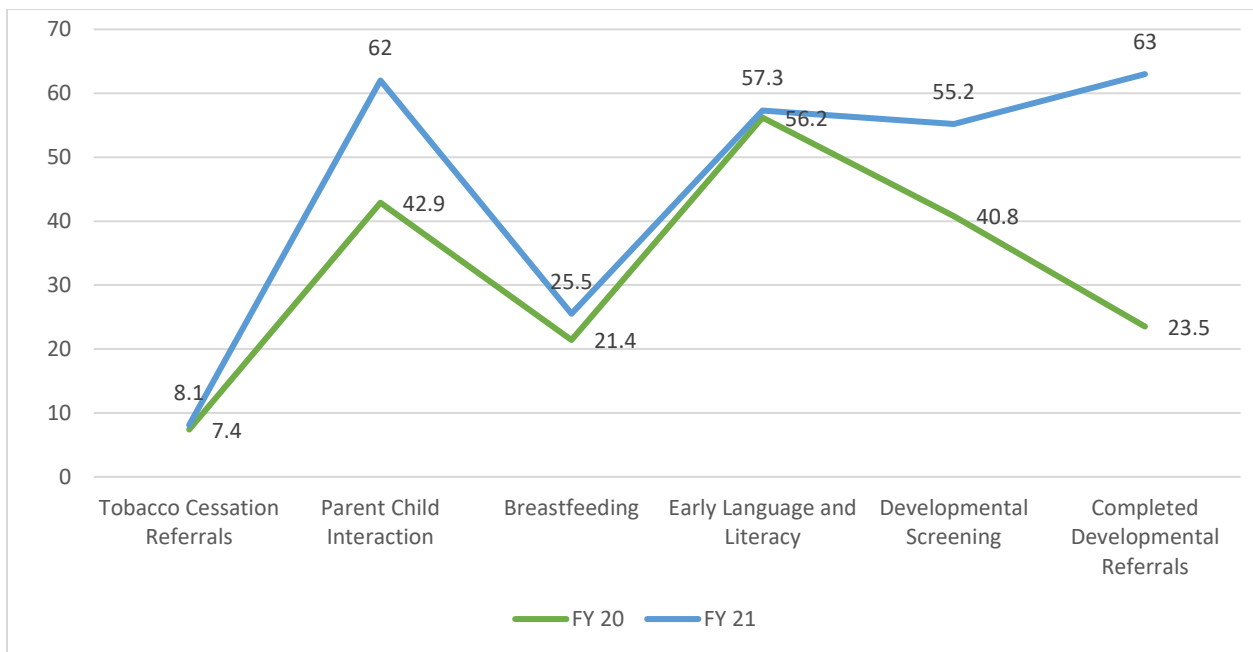
